

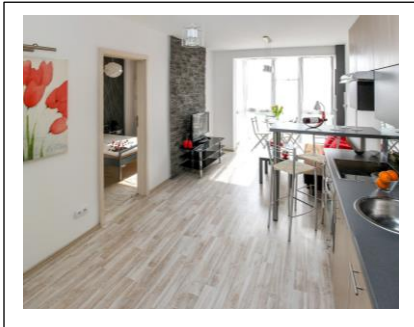

Possible answers.

3. A – It's nice, but too white. B – The desk is wide enough, but the seat isn't comfortable enough. C – This is the most comfortable chair, but the desk is too small.
